

Edgewood Tahoe, Lake Tahoe, Calif.

- 18 Holes
- 7,532 Yards
- Par 72

It's not at one of the area ski resorts, but this lakeside course is undeniably one of the prettiest in the region. Set at 6.200 feet right at Lake Tahoe's shoreline, the course was designed to never let you forget where you are. Designed by George Fazio and updated by his renowned golf-architect nephew Tom Fazio, the Edgewood course is known for a mix of challenge and surprise features around every corner.
