

CONDITION OF ENTRY AND USE OF ICE RINK

- Skating is enjoyed at your own risk.
- Please skate safely and responsibly.
- Helmets, gloves, and warm, comfortable clothing are recommended.
- Skaters and parents/guardians of skaters using the ice rink, acknowledge that there is a risk of injury in ice skating, and by entering the ice rink area you freely accept that risk and liability for any injury sustained as a result of skating here or being in or around the ice rink.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USING THE ICE SKATING RINK

For safety and enjoyment of all patrons the following regulations apply while enjoying the ice rink.

- 1. All persons skate at their own risk
- 2. Skate safely and under control at all times
- 3. Skate in a counter-clockwise direction unless advised otherwise
- 4. Children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- 5. Smallest ice skate available is a children's size 12
- 6. Patrons are not permitted on the ice without ice skates
- 7. Food or drink is not permitted on the ice at any time
- 8. Do not carry children, phones, cameras, bags or other items while on the ice
- 9. Please be courteous and respectful of all patrons and staff
- 10. Use caution as the ice surface may be uneven or wet.
- 11. Intoxicated patrons will be removed from the ice or refused entry.
- 12. Edgewood Tahoe Resort reserves the right to remove patrons from the ice if it deems there is a risk to the safety of other patrons or the individual.
- 13. Patrons must obey the instructions and directions of rink and event staff.
- 14. Patrons disobeying the instructions of rink and event staff and/or posted signs will be asked to leave the ice rink.
- 15. Sessions may proceed in inclement weather unless the conditions are deemed unsafe.
- 16. Smoking and vaping is prohibited on the premises
