



MASTERCRAFT BOAT RENTALS - FAQ

Get ready to take your on-water experience to a whole new level. In partnership with MasterCraft, Edgewood Tahoe carries an exclusive fleet of select boats. Our Mastercraft X24 Wakesurf boat, MasterCraft NXT24, and Crest Pontoon boats are conveniently located at the Edgewood Tahoe Pier for our resort guests' exclusive use.

How do we book?

Guests can book directly through this exclusive access page or in person with the Edgewood Tahoe concierge team. A \$500 deposit is required for future bookings. Day-of bookings and walk-ups are possible at our watersport kiosk near the pier, *pending availability*. How many people can come?

The X24 comfortably hosts up to six passengers plus the captain—the U.S. Coast Guard limits charters to six passengers. The NXT24 and Crest Pontoon boats can each hold up to 12 passengers.

Are fuel and taxes included in the rate?

Price is inclusive of fuel, but tax and crew gratuity are not included.

Can we bill to our room?

All payments will need to be made directly through our partnering vendor.

Can we drive the boat ourselves?

The MasterCraft X24 requires a captain. The MasterCraft NXT24 and Crest Pontoon boats do not have captains; guests drive themselves and can assign drivers at their discretion.

Do I need a boating license?

Boaters aged 35 years or younger operating a craft on interstate waters, such as Lake Tahoe, need their boater education card. Despite the generally safe conditions afforded by Lake Tahoe, boaters need to be prepared for dangerous situations.

What are the minimum time requirements to rent a boat?

There is a 2-hour minimum to rent the MasterCraft X24. The MasterCraft NXT24 and Crest Pontoon boats are only available for ½ day of 3 hours or a full day of 7 hours.

What watersports can we do on the boats?

The MasterCraft X24 is equipped only for wakesurfing. The MasterCraft NXT24 has limited water toys available, including tubing. The Crest Pontoon boats are not equipped for watersports.

Where do we meet & check in?

Meet the team at the Edgewood Tahoe watersports kiosk next to the pier.

What should we bring?

We encourage you to bring non-spray sunscreen, warm layers, sunglasses, a hat, and your Edgewood Tahoe refillable water bottle. Towels will be provided.

Are we allowed to bring our service animals?

Service animals are not allowed onboard the MasterCraft X24, NXT24, or any of the Crest Pontoon boats.

Do you offer food and beverages on board?

Edgewood Tahoe offers a special boat-friendly menu provided to you in a travel cooler. Eight-hour advance notice is required. Connect with an Edgewood Tahoe team member to learn more about our picnic-style food offerings at the concierge desk located in the lobby or activities@edgewoodtahoe.com.

Are life jackets provided?

The MasterCraft team will ensure that each person on board is fitted for a PFD (personal floatation device), including children and infants.

What should we not bring?

We ask that you refrain from bringing messy food such as Cheetos or chocolate. Please avoid footwear such as hiking boots or high-heeled shoes that could damage the boat's seats. Sustainability is critical at Edgewood Tahoe, so we ask you to avoid single-use products such as Styrofoam coolers, plastic bags, and plastic bottles. Edgewood Tahoe does not allow pets on the property.

What is your cancellation and refund policy?

We have a 72-hour cancellation policy. All trips canceled within the 72-hour window will not receive their \$500 deposit. If a refund is issued, it will return to the original form of payment. Weather cancellations are at the captain's discretion.
